## Contest – Focus on 4-H Logo!

- Created by a current 4-H member
- Black and white – hand drawn or computer generated (your own work)
- Include “20<sup>th</sup> Annual” , “Focus on 4-H” and “Northwest Region”
- Include the 4-H logo (correct logo includes the clover, 4-H Canada, and 4-H Alberta; and can be downloaded from <http://www.4h.ab.ca/downloads/>)
- May incorporate the current Focus on 4-H logo, but is not required to
- Be a maximum size of 3.5” x 5” (9 X 12.5 cm)
