Grandma Shirley's 4H Horse Camp**

To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of the friends of the late Shirley Woods and the East Central 4H Regional Horse Council, I ask you to consider sponsoring our 8th annual Grandma Shirley's 4H Horse Camp.

4H is a youth organization that focuses on 9-21 year olds. It incorporates many life skills, such as record keeping, public speaking, marketing, judging, livestock care and handling, and fundraising.

In September of 2011 the East Central Region lost long-time 4-H leader, "Grandma" Shirley Woods, to cancer. On the May 2019 long weekend, in Donalda, Alberta, we will be hosting our 8th annual interactive 4 day riding camp to honour and remember Shirley's incredible contribution to the 4H program. This camp will be an opportunity for equine project members of the East (priority given) and other 4H regions to come together for 4 days of fun and learning. For our camp last year, we had more than 30 4H members and their horses attend.

We are excited to give the members a chance to try a variety of different activities at a minimal cost - activities which they may not otherwise have an opportunity to experience. In previous year these activities included Western and English horsemanship, polocrosse, jumping, mounted shooting, equine dentistry, packing, gymkhana events, trail, roping, goat tying among others. The members get a chance to get competitive and show off the skills they have learned with a horseshow scheduled at the end of the weekend.

Various volunteers have been working hard to plan for this event. Funds raised are used for costs such as facility rental, clinic instructors, judges, prizes, meals, etc. Financial assistance with these costs helps us to keep the registration fees for the members as low as possible to make the camp accessible for all.

In addition to donations towards the operating costs, we are also seeking sponsorship to go towards prizes and awards which will be handed out to the members for various things throughout the weekend. Please find attached an overview of the donations and prizes we have in mind.
